The module incorporates an electrically isolated base plate and low inductance construction enabling circuit designers to optimise circuit layouts and utilise grounded heat sinks for safety.

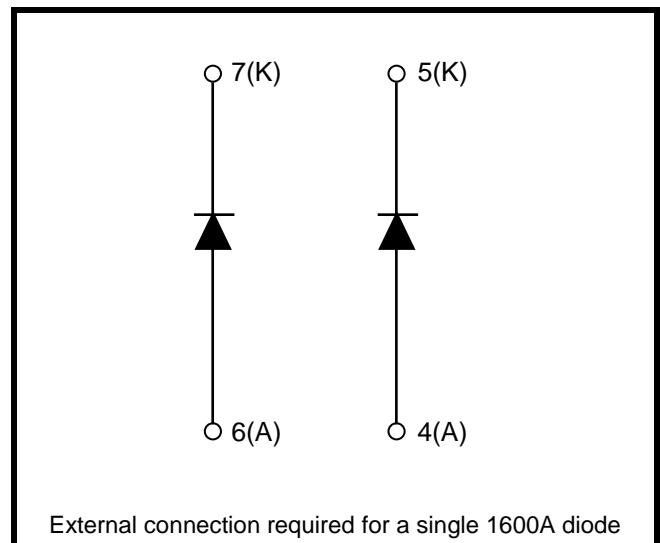


Fig. 1 Circuit configuration

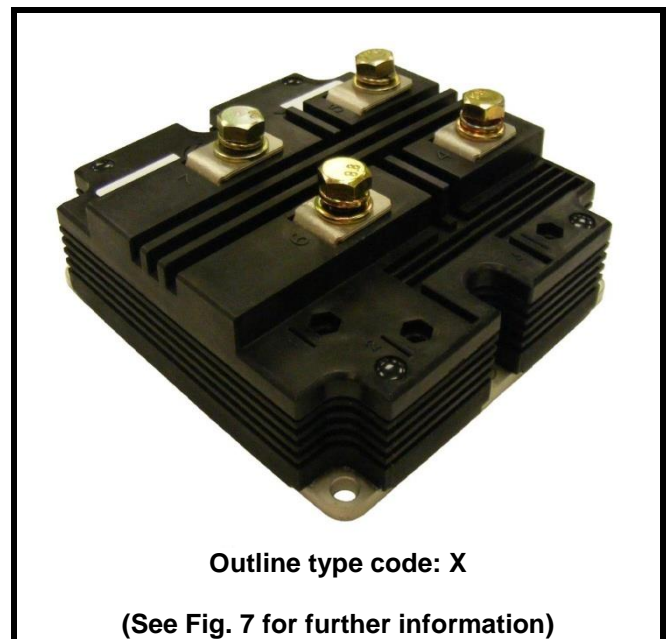


Fig. 2 Package

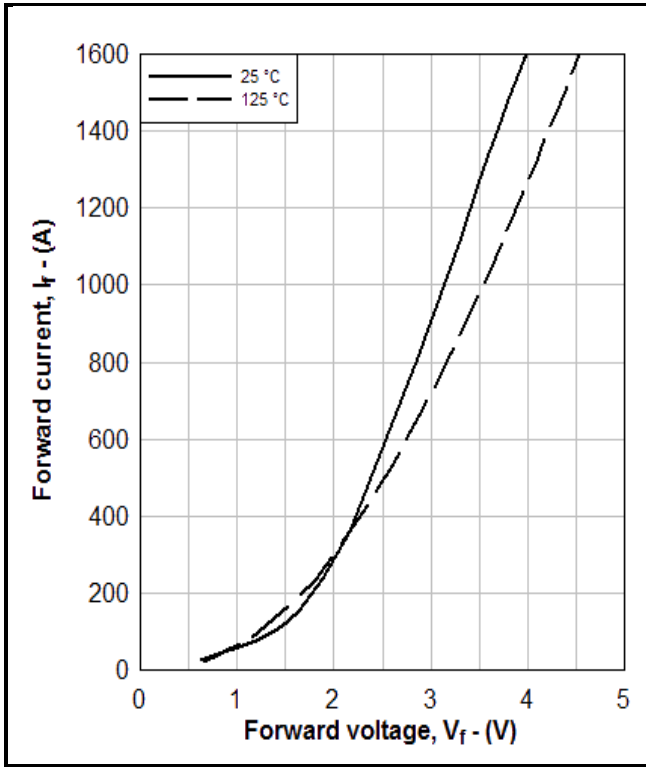


Fig. 3 Diode typical forward characteristics

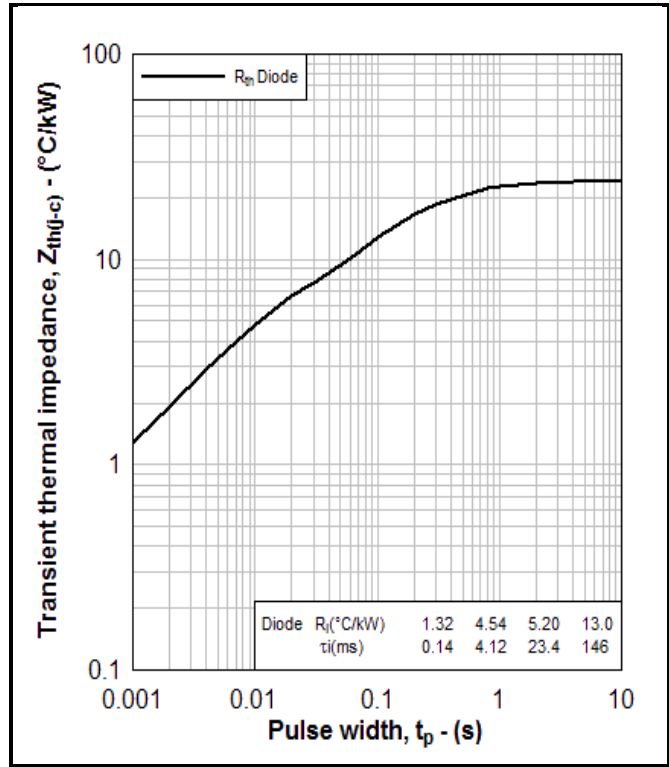


Fig. 4 Transient thermal impedance

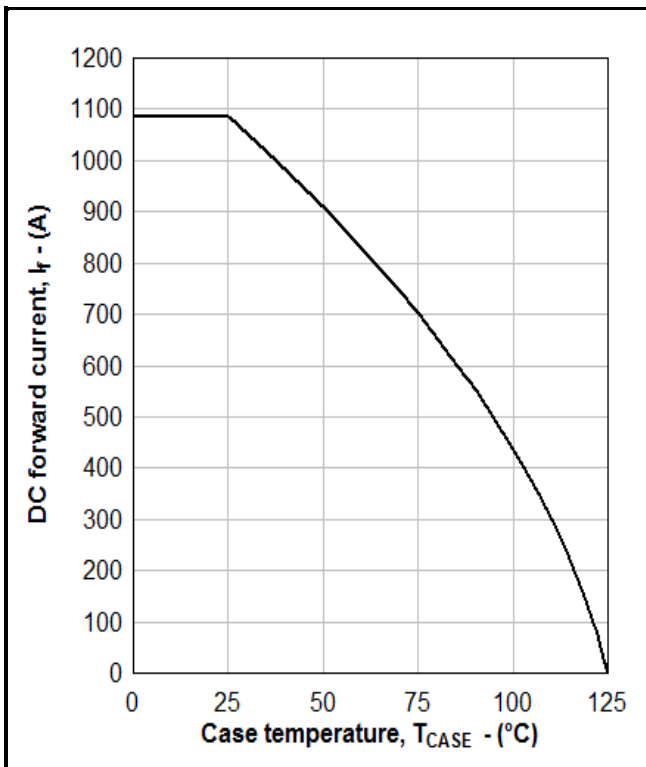


Fig. 5 DC current rating vs case temperature

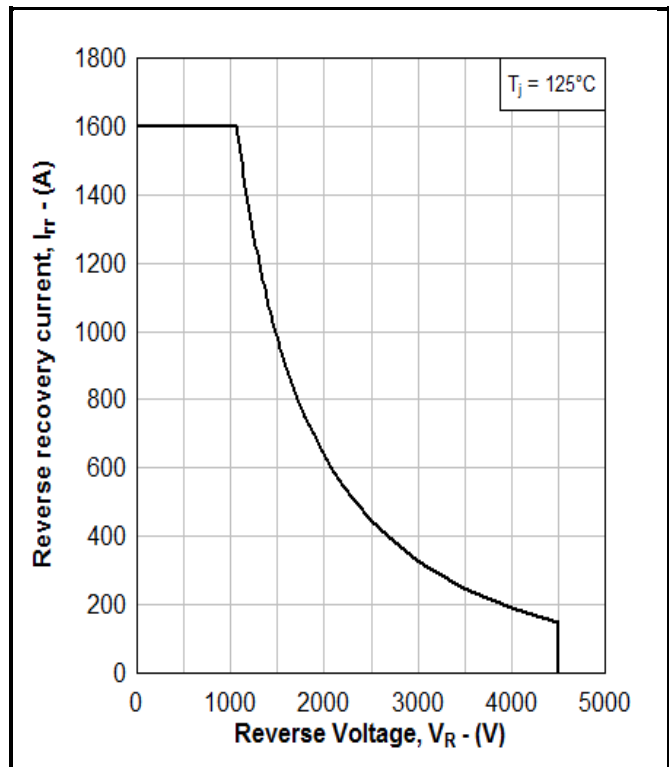


Fig. 6 Reverse Bias Safe Operating Area (RBSOA)

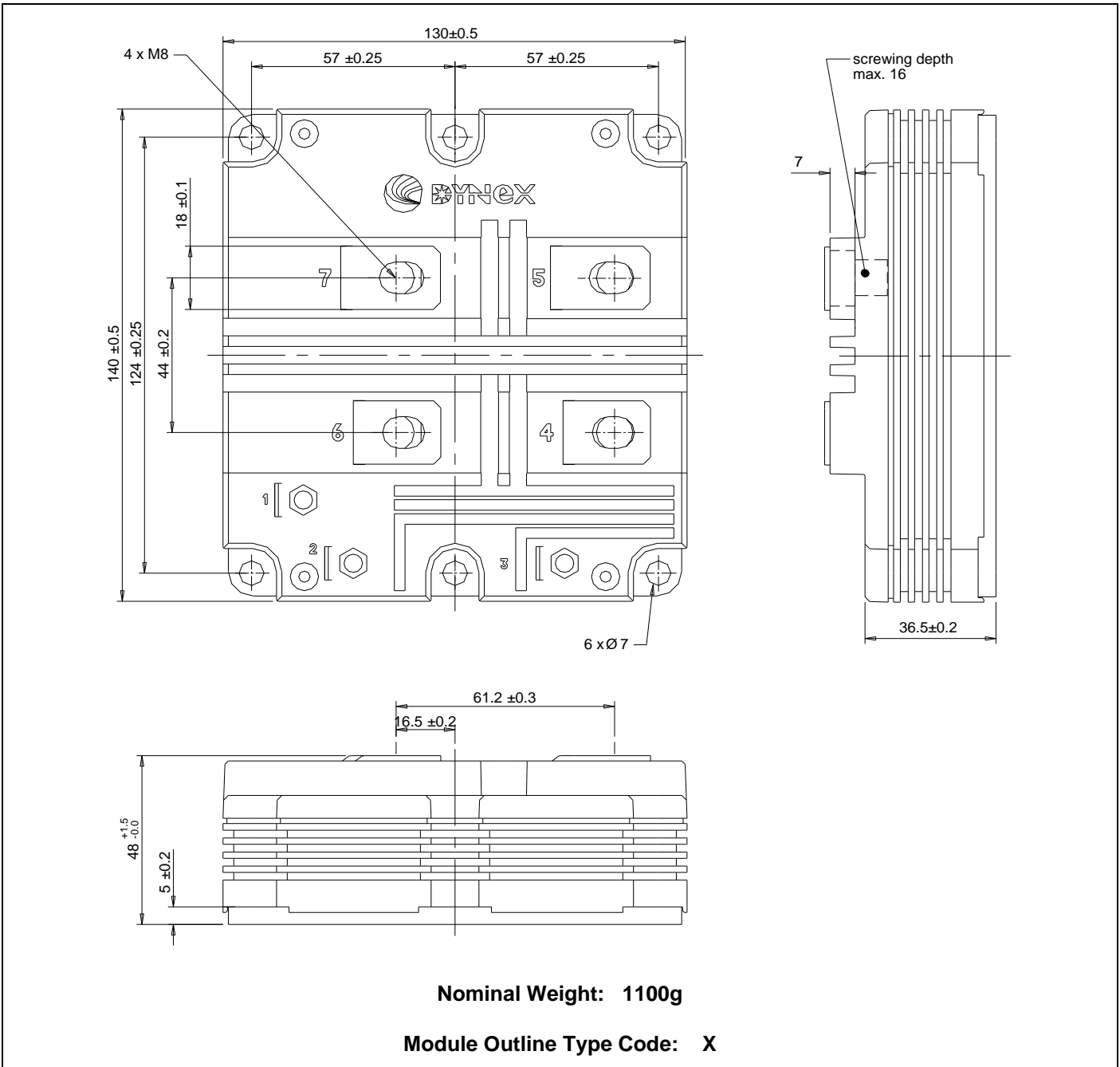


Fig. 7 Module outline drawing
